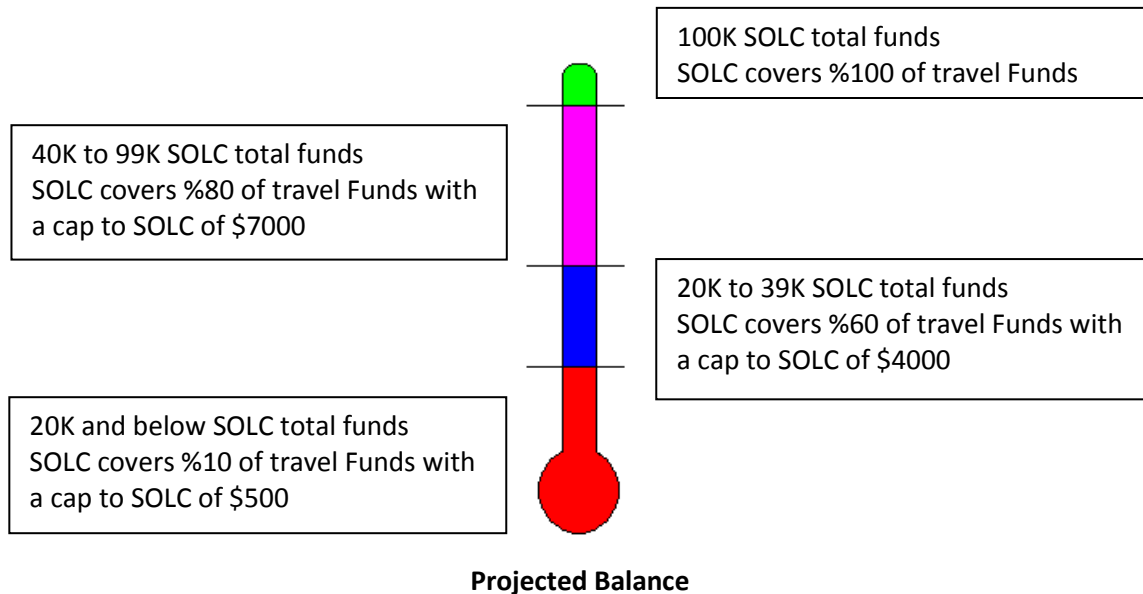


# SPECIAL OLYMPICS Virginia Loudoun County Area 14 POLICY STATEMENT of FUNDING FOR TRAVEL TO NON SOVA EVENTS

This Policy Statement sets forth the procedure for funding of travel by athletes participating in Area 14 programs. The funding requirements provided for in this Policy Statement apply to all travel by Special Olympic athletes and volunteers from Area 14 for events outside the North Section and North Central Section of Special Olympics Virginia, Except for travel to Special Olympics Virginia State Championships. This policy is in conjunction with "Travel-funding-request-form". This form must be completed and submitted before funding can be requested and approved by the SOLC council.

Funding for travel to non SOVA events is an exception not the rule. Funding is on a sliding scale based upon SOLC total funds after that's year budgets expenditures (See Drawing below). This will be known as "Projected Balance"



Example1:

Trip cost = \$12,000  
 Requestors percentage (%20) = \$2400  
 SOLC percentage (%80) = \$9600  
 SOLC Cap (\$7000)  
 Requestors Portion they need to raise = \$5000

Example2:

Trip cost = \$4,000  
 Requestors percentage (%20) = \$800  
 SOLC percentage (%80) = \$3200  
 SOLC Cap (\$7000)  
 Requestors Portion they need to raise = \$800

The Trip coordinator is responsible for supervising the requesters portion of the trips fundraising and the fundraising cannot come from general SOLC fundraising. If the trip coordinator/requesters do not reach their portion of the funds, then their portion can be held for one year to try to complete the goal amount. The sliding scale will be reset to the Projected Balance at the time. If the goal is not reached after the year's extension then the funds revert back to the SOLC general funds.
